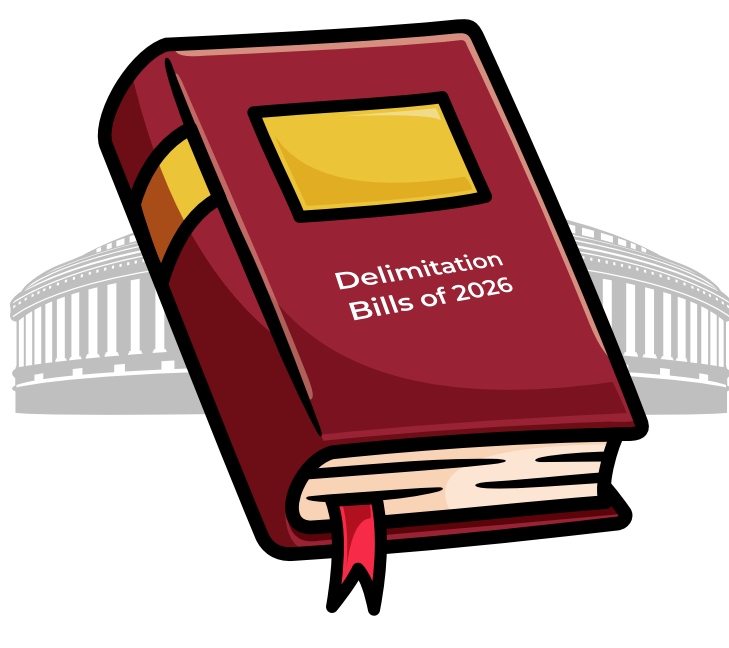

### 2 The Constitution (131st Amendment) Bill, 2026

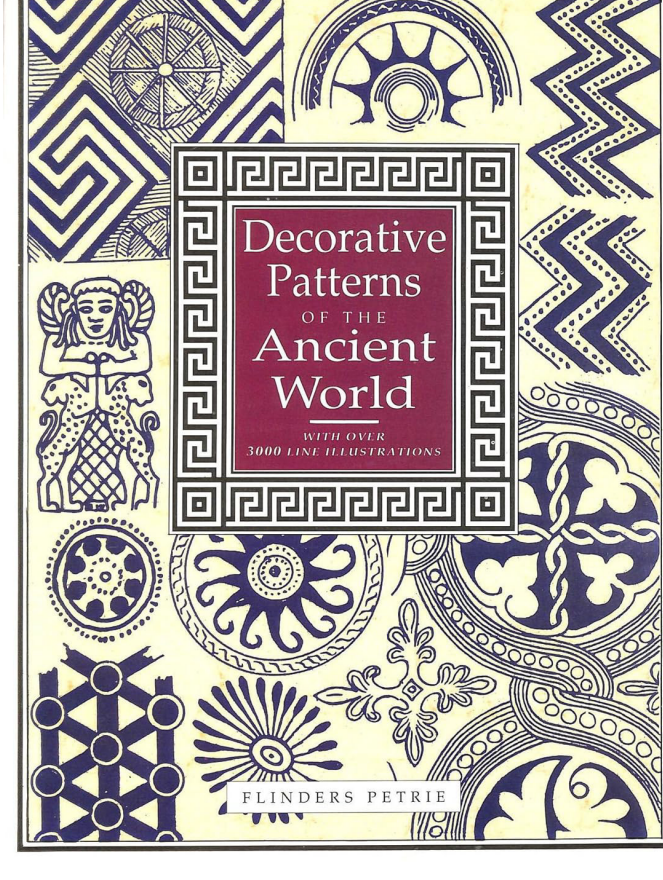
#### [Delimitation Bills of 2026]

The Constitution provides that seats in the Lok Sabha must be allocated to states in proportion to their population. Further, constituencies within each state should have roughly the same population. It requires that constituencies be redrawn (also called delimited) after each census. Similar provisions apply to the State Assemblies.



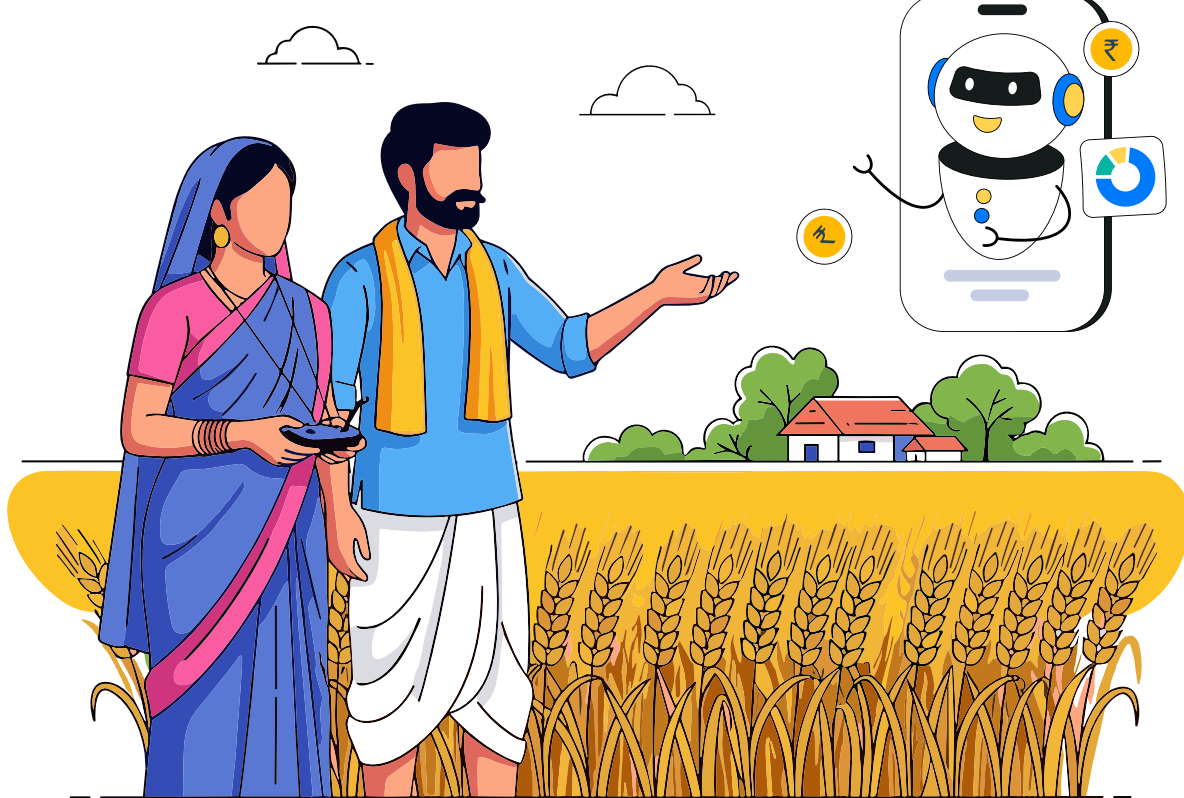
### 3 Decorative Patterns Of The Ancient World
